Dorothy S. Palmer, affectionately known as “Sis,” died in 2015 following a long illness.

Dorothy S. Palmer, affectionately known as “Sis,” grew up in West Hartford, where she graduated from Hall High School, and Simmons College in Boston. The Palmers raised their children in Wethersfield and at her beloved Stannard Beach in Westbrook. For many years, Sis studied painting with Paul Zimmerman of West Hartford and became an accomplished artist. She was granted membership in the American Watercolor Society, the Connecticut Watercolor Society, the art associations and art leagues in West Hartford, Madison, Clinton, Essex and Mystic. In 1982, she won the Paul Remy Award presented by the American Watercolor Society. Her paintings were shown in galleries in New York City, Palm Beach, Boston and throughout Connecticut. Her work is in private collections across the United States. Until the last years of her life, Sis maintained an active studio in her homes in Westbrook and North Hutchinson Island, Fla.
