About the Artist:

Nancy T. Greene, an artist and member of several state art associations, died Wednesday at John N. Dempsey Hospital. She was 67.

A resident of Avon, Greene had lived in the Farmington Valley for 40 years.

In the past 20 years, her paintings had been exhibited and had won awards at many state galleries. She also had one-woman exhibits at the CPTV Gallery 24, the Gallery on the Green in Canton, the West Hartford Congregational Church and the Chimney Gallery in West Hartford. Her work also appeared in more than 100 juried shows.

Greene's art association memberships included the West Hartford Art League, the Connecticut Watercolor Society, the Wintonbury Art League, Connecticut Women Artists and the Connecticut Academy of Fine Arts.

She was a member of the West Hartford Art League board of trustees for 10 years.

In 1951, she graduated cum laude from Syracuse University. She also studied at the West Hartford Art League, the Hartford Art School and the former Greater Hartford Community College.
